



HLTFA301B Course in Apply First Aid

The purpose of the Course in Apply First Aid is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance

Entry requirements: Nil

Pre & Co-requisites: Nil

Duration: 16 hours

Venue: This program can be conducted at your location of business or at a venue that is suitable and convenient to the participants. First Intervention is able to deliver this course at a time to suit your needs

Class Size: Normally a minimum of six (6) participants is required and a maximum of 24 participants is allowed.

Prerequisites: Nil

Content:

- Chain of Survival
- Patient Assessment
- CPR
- Legal Responsibilities
- Management of common medical conditions
- Trauma Management
- Haemorrhage Control
- Documentation
- Recording Patient Information
- Drug Overdoses

Evaluation: Competency is assessed during the course by way of practical demonstration and questioning to confirm essential knowledge.

Certificates: On successful completion of this course participants are awarded a Course in First Aid in a Remote Situation Certificate. This certificate is valid for a period of 3 years from the date of issue. Certification for CPR is valid for a period of 12 months from the date of issue and therefore it is recommended that qualifications be updated regularly thereafter.

Next Step: Participants who have successfully completed this course are encouraged to undertake the Course HLTFA402B Apply Advanced First Aid.
