



UETTDRRF10B Provide First Aid in an ESI Environment

This purpose of the course *Provide First Aid in an ESI Environment* is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to recognise and initiate a response where first aid is required in emergency situations by providing essential first aid using basic life support measures according to established workplace first aid policies and procedures.

Entry requirements: Nil.

Pre & Co-requisites: Nil

Duration: 3 hours

Venue: This program can be conducted at your location of business or at a venue that is suitable and convenient to the participants. First Intervention is able to deliver this course at a time to suit your needs

Class Size: Normally a minimum of eight (8) participants is required and a maximum of 20 participants is allowed.

Content:

- Prepare First aid in and ESI Environment
- Indentify Hazards & Minimise Risks
- Assess and stabilise the Casualty
- Provision of first aid for conditions including Bleeding, Burns, Electrocutation, Bites, Stings and Envenomation
- Assess the condition
- Requesting Ambulance Support
- Patient Reassurance / Communications
- Reporting details of accident /incident

Evaluation: Competency is assessed during the course by way of practical demonstration of skills using a model of the human body (resuscitation manikin) in line with ARC guidelines. CPR Knowledge and skills must be demonstrated in line with State / Territory guidelines also.

Certificates: On successful completion of this course participants are awarded a Statement of Attainment in *Provide first aid in an ESI environment*. This certification displays a valid period of 12 months from the date of issue and therefore it is recommended that qualifications be updated regularly thereafter.
