PROVIDE FIRST AID IN AN ESI ENVIRONMENT

Modification History: *Release 1.* This is the first release of this unit of competency in the UET Transmission, Distribution and Rail Sector Training Package.

Application: This unit covers the provision of first aid in an electricity supply industry (ESI) environment. It includes the recognition and provision of an initial response where first aid is required in emergency situations by providing essential first aid using basic life support measures according to established workplace first aid policies and procedures.

The application of the skills and knowledge described in this unit may require a licence/registration to practice in the workplace subject to regulations for undertaking of electrical work.

Other conditions may apply under state and territory legislative and regulatory licencing requirements which must be confirmed prior to commencing this unit.

Pre-requisite Unit: HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

Competency Field: Refresher Training

Duration: 3 hours

Venue: This program can be conducted at your location of business or at a venue that is suitable and convenient to the participants. First Intervention is able to deliver this course at a time to suit your needs

Class Size: Normally a minimum of eight (8) participants is required with a maximum of 20 participants allowed.

Evaluation: Competency is assessed during the course by way of practical demonstration of skills using a model of the human body (resuscitation manikin) in line with ARC guidelines. CPR Knowledge and skills must be demonstrated in line with State / Territory guidelines also.

Certificate: On successful completion of this course participants are awarded a *Statement of Attainment in Provide first aid in an ESI environment*, which displays a validity period of 12 months from issuance to the student. It is therefore recommended that this unit of competency be updated regularly.
